Parking: There is a large parking lot located on the east side of the building. There is also plentiful free street parking around the school.

Entrance: All participants will enter the school through Door #1 which is on the north side of the building.

Sign-in tables: The sign-in tables will be located on the 2nd floor outside of the TD room and main school office. There will be signs and people assisting to direct everyone entering the building to the sign-in tables on the 2nd floor. After signing in, participants will then make their way back down to the 1st floor skittles area.

Skittles area: The whole 1st floor will be used as the skittles area for players on teams smaller than 10 participants. There are two cafeterias and a large hallway that can be used as team areas. Teams with over 10 participants will be given a team room on the day of the tournament.

Tournament playing area: All sections will compete on the 4th floor. K-8 novice section (Pawns, Knights, Bishops, Rooks) players will play in the gymnasium and the intermediate and advanced sections will play in 4th floor classrooms which will be marked by signs.

Tournament Directors room: The TD will be located in room 103, and the volunteer room will be located next to the TD room. No participants are allowed in the TD room. For questions, you will be directed to the volunteer room. There will also be a volunteer room on the 4th floor.

Food sales: Concessions will be available in the cafeteria on the 1st floor.

Trophy presentations: All trophy presentations will take place in the auditorium on the 2nd floor.
