GoCPS is a new online platform to streamline the high school application process for Chicago Public Schools.

Rank Rank these school and program choices based on their preferences




Be Matched Be matched with their highest possible choice for high school


Five Phases to Apply

We have developed a five phased approach to guide you through the application process.

Subscribing to GoCPS

Subscribing to GoCPS is the first step in the high school application process. It is very important that we have an updated and active way of contacting you to walk you through the application process.

By subscribing you will:

- Receive instructions and announcements that are critical to completing your application.
- Get reminders about key application milestones like account activation and high school program eligibility access.
- Be among the first to know when new application system features are released to the public.
- Get alerts about recruitment and open house event dates.

In order to apply to high schools in October 2017, you will need to create a GoCPS account.

Between June 8 – 14, you should receive a letter from CPS with an Activation Code. This code will be used to create your GoCPS account in August 2017 when the application functions of the website are made available.

Now that you've subscribed, you will get an email in August with instructions on how to create this account.

Activation Code Letter Example

Thank you for your interest in applying to the Chicago Public Schools for the 2018-2019 school year. Beginning this year, the CPS high school application process will use a new conline platform to streamline the high school application process. For the district **GoCPS** (<u>ncorp.adg</u>). Below is the Activation Code (previously called a PDN) that you will need to create your GoCPS account in August 2017:

With GoCPS, you will be able to manage the entire application process online, giving you the ability to review school and program options in one place, rank these school and program choices based on your preferences, and be matched with your highest-ranked choice on your application for which you qualify and that has available seats. This new application process follows five plases:

1. Subscribe (May - June 2017): Sign up to receive important updates and announcements at go.cps.edu

- 2. Research (June July 2017): Conduct detailed research to find the best school for your child
- 3. Activate (August September 2017): Create an account and access your child's program eligibility
- 4. Apply (October December 2017): Complete applications with one system and one deadline
- 5. Match (January June 2018): Get matched and receive high school offers

Now that you have your Activation Code, it is very important that you complete the first step in the application process by subscribing to GoCPS, if you have not already done so.

VISIT GO.CPS.EDU AND SUBSCRIBE TODAY.

After you subscribe to <u>go.cps.edu</u>, you will receive notices and reminders when key functions of the application process are opened to the public, including a notice in August 2017, to use your Activation Code to create your GoCPS account and access your child's high school program eligibility information. By receiving your code before the end of this school year, you can create your colline account during the summer and spend more time researching schools.

Please save this Activation Code in an easy-to-find location until August and see the reverse of this letter for important Frequently Asked Questions regarding the high school application process.
